## BIOGRAPHY

Pat Matuloa (1952- ) studied art at a host of small schools and art centres before obtaining a Diploma in Fine Art from the prestigious ELC Art Centre at Rorke's Drift, Natal. He became a full-time artist in 1992, and has participated in several significant local and international exhibitions. With David Koloane, Bill Ainslie and other South African artists he was involved in the formation in 1985 of the Thupelo Workshops, which are part of the international Triangle Network. He taught at FUBA (federated Union of Black Artists) from the early 1980s and was instrumental in the Thupelo Gallery there. He is currently based at the Fordsburg Artist's Studios, popularly known as The Bag Factory.
